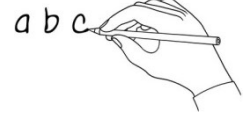




# The lion and the mouse

Write the word under the pictures.

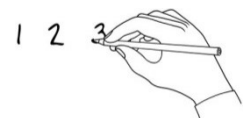

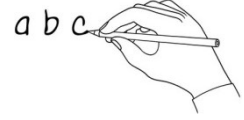

- d. Does the lion think the mouse can help him?

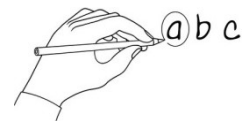
